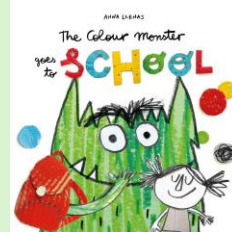
Trips and Special Events

LITERACY

Through our English unit, children will explore a wide range of texts and writing styles, including diary entries, descriptions, and narrative writing. They will develop their reading and writing skills by learning how different texts are structured and used for different purposes. We will use Colourful Semantics to support children in organising their ideas and building clear, well-structured sentences. Learning activities will be linked to our Book of the Week, providing meaningful opportunities for reading, role play, writing, and creative tasks that bring stories and texts to life.

Every day we will also practise our handwriting, phonics and read a wide variety of exceptional texts during our reading for pleasure time.



Geography

In Geography we are looking at answering the question 'Where in the world are we?' We are going to be learning about and exploring the local area.

History

We will explore how things have changed over time and the difference between the past and the present. We will focus on how schools have changed from the time of our grandparents.

RE

We will be looking at understanding Christianity

MATHS

We follow the NCTEM and Oak National Academy.

This Autumn we will be looking at recapping previous reception experiences and focusing on number and place value where we will be counting within 100.

We will then move on to parts and whole models before we begin addition and subtraction where we look at Composition of numbers 0 to 5.

There will also be many problem-solving opportunities throughout each topic.

PSHE

We follow the Jigsaw Scheme and will cover the topics Being me in my world and Celebrating difference.

Computing

We will start with an online safety unit as well as looking at different computing systems and their network.

PE

Indoor: Gymnastics – Basic skills
Outdoor: We have Arena leading our PE session

SCIENCE

Our topic is Seasons and Weather. We will name and describe what happens in all four seasons and how the trees and weather can change.

We also look at 'My body' where we learn about the key parts of the body and explain what these body parts are used for and the sense they are associated with.

ART and DT

DT: We will look at structures where we talk about how to make stable structures and produce our own pencil pot.

Art: We will start by looking at exploring line and shape through drawing and exploring the work of the artist Klee.

Music

We will look at keeping the pulse together through music and movement, by exploring our favourite things.
