Trips and Special Events

This term we will be holding an Egyptian day, a parent DT workshop as well as completing a welly walk in our local area to look at the River Erme.

MATHS

We are using a new Maths scheme which is supported by the NCETM (National Centre for Excellence in Teaching Mathematics). We will be using Oak National schemes of work to help us deliver our maths lessons. It focuses on revisiting and building on previous skills and deepening maths knowledge.

This autumn we will cover

- Adding and subtracting across 10.
- Numbers to 1000
- Right angles

SCIENCE

We will start the term with science unit light. We will explore how light shines and reflects on different materials and look at exploring how shadows are made and change with the position of the light source. Later in term, we will explore different forces and magnets.

ENGLISH

In English we will be looking at the following texts: The beasties, Rainforest rough guide, Meerkat Mail and The snowman.

Through these units we will explore writing our own narratives linked to the texts, descriptions and nonfiction texts.

We will focus on using conjunctions to join sentences, understanding prepositional phrases and verb choices.



PSHE

We follow the Jigsaw Scheme and will cover the topics 'being me in the world' and 'celebrating differences'.

ART and DT

DT: We will be covering our textiles unit and will explore making Egyptian collars linked to our History topic. This is a project we will be inviting you in to share with us.

Art: We will be looking at prehistoric painting and how we can paint using prehistoric methods.

Geography

Rivers: After studying the Indus river in India and the Severn in the UK, we discuss how rivers, people and land all affect each other.

Mountains: From Ben Nevis to Mount Everest, what is a mountain?

History

We will start the term learning about the ancient Egyptians. Following on from this we will look at the cradles of civilisation and how this changed in history.

Computing

We will be for the first term focusing on ESafety. Later in the term we will look at connecting computer exploring how digital devices connect to a network.

Music

Ballads – We will learn what a Ballad is, practise performing Ballads as well as writing part of our own song to perform.

RE

We will focus on Hinduism across the term. Looking and famous stories and how their beliefs were shared
